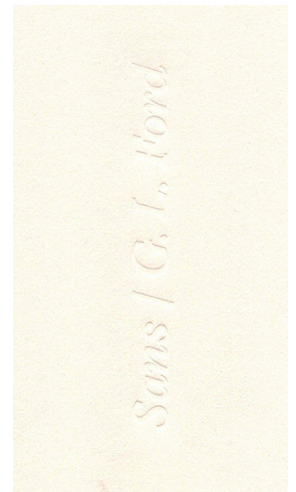


G. L. Ford
